Zac Wallace, of Wallace Architects, LLC, attended the Fairgrounds Villa Senior Apartments Ribbon Cutting Ceremony in Warrenton, Missouri on October 12th, 2017, hosted by the North East Community Action Corporation (NECAC).

In December of 2015, NECAC was awarded affordable housing tax credits from the Missouri Housing Development Commission to construct (40) two-bedroom, energy efficient housing units. Less than two years later, tenants have moved in and their praises could not be higher.

"I have lived in a mobile home most of my life, my Unit is well laid out and BRAND NEW! I am able to live in a beautiful property and much cheaper than my last residence," says Susan.

"I used to live in the country. This place is close to my family and shops. I love it, my neighbors are friendly and so is the staff," says Frances.

Fairgrounds Villa was established to provide housing for income qualifying individuals ages 62 and older. While attending the Ribbon Cutting, we heard from new tenants about how their new homes have had a positive impact on life, bringing them closer to family, and creating a sense of community while at the same time lowering their cost of living. We are proud to find that the efforts of NECAC and Wallace Architects has resulted in beautiful homes for many residents of Warrenton.

"I was the first tenant to move in. I was so excited that I stopped by every week they were building," says Susan.

The Kitchen, Inc. partnering with Housing Plus, L.L.C., was awarded affordable housing tax credits from the Missouri Housing Development Commission to construct the 36 Unit development. The development was designed to service the community's need for affordable housing and the property caters to the needs of senior citizens 55+ and reserves six units for formerly homeless veterans and their families. Residents began to move in to this development in late summer, 2017.

"I've been a homeless man since about 1990, and I have survived being homeless by sleeping in parks, sleeping in abandoned houses, sleeping in the tree line and sleeping in my car. Today, I tell people, I am living the dream, that normalcy. I have a roof, I have security. Wow," says Robert. (KY3)


"I love to walk my dog along the sidewalks multiple time a day with my neighbors." says Karen.
