Award Winning Projects in Connecticut and Oklahoma

Wallace Architects is delighted to be recognized by two outstanding organizations for our collaboration and execution of several projects.

The Connecticut Building Congress, or CBC, has awarded the 2018 Project Team Award to the team who collaborated on the Carrol Building Historic Rehabilitation in Waterbury, Connecticut. Each year, the CBC recognizes developments whose team members have met or surpassed goals and achieved higher quality through teamwork.



Two other developments have also received awards. The Oklahoma Historical Society's State Historic Preservation Office has presented Wallace Architects with two 2018 Citation of Merit Awards for their rehabilitation of the Will Rogers Hotel in Claremore, Ok. and the Berryhill Building in Sapulpa, Ok.



The Will Rogers Hotel is a six-story, 64,300-square-foot building, constructed in 1929 that currently provides affordable housing to the residents of Claremore. The Berryhill Building, originally an office building built in 1909, has also been rehabilitated for affordable housing preservation.

The Citation of Merit is awarded for outstanding accomplishments in historic preservation. Recipients are recognized for their exemplary efforts to further historic preservation at the local, State or National level.
