Affordable Housing Advocacy



On Tuesday February 25th, Zac Wallace, along with a number of other MoWHA members traveled to Jefferson City to offer testimony to the Senate Economic Development subcommittee in favor of Senate Bill 549. This Bill would partially restore the Missouri State LIHTC. We strongly support this Bill and believe that its passage is necessary if we are going to begin to adequately address the shortage of affordable housing units in the State of Missouri.

Zac's advocacy efforts continued on March 5th in Washington D.C. He is a member of the board of directors for the CARH organization (Council for Affordable and Rural Housing). This group travels to Capitol Hill twice a year to meet with lawmakers and their staff to advocate for affordable housing in rural America. They advocated for a number of topics that would help ease the affordable housing crisis in rural communities. Topics included H.R. 5187 "Housing is Infrastructure Act", S. 1703 and H.R. 3077 "Affordable Housing Credit Improvement Act of 2019", and numerous appropriation priorities affecting rural communities.
